He presents 'Oneness Consciousness' as a path toward healing, love, and spiritual wholeness.

1. The Crisis of Masculinity

The Blueprint for Self-Destruction

Masculinity defined by stoicism, competition, and dominance leads to emotional self-destruction.

Masculine Socialization as Trauma

Boys are shamed for emotional expression, causing loss of authenticity and relational disconnect.

Addiction to External Validation

Men seek worth through performance, not inner truth—leading to addiction, shame, and aggression.

2. Empire Consciousness – The Cultural Root

Definition

A system based on power, control, hierarchy, fear, and scarcity.

Cultural Effects

Promotes emotional numbness, addiction, bullying, and systems of oppression.

In Boys

Empire training teaches domination or emotional withdrawal, especially in pain.

Shifting to Oneness Consciousness
